SOUTH COAST PLAZA AREA MAP

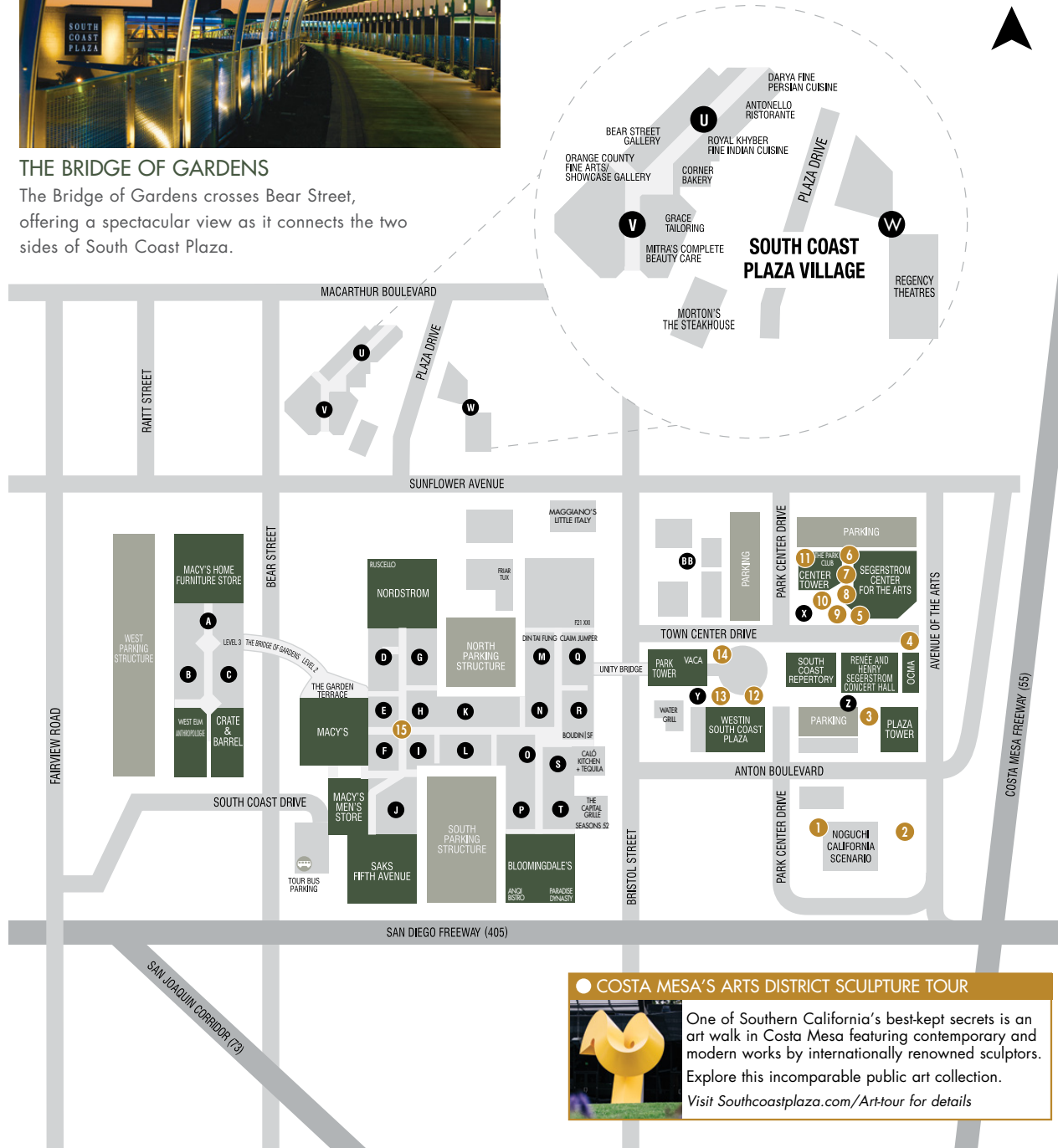

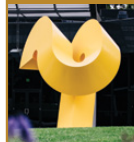
