Title: Neurocognitive and Quality of Life Outcomes in individuals with Down Syndrome

Participant Criteria

Parents of individuals with Down syndrome with <u>no</u> history of childhood cancer. Must speak English, Spanish, or French.

Description

We are studying neurocognitive and quality of life outcomes in individuals with Down syndrome and a history of childhood cancer. We want to learn if cancer treatment changes thinking and learning, behavior, and quality of life for these survivors. We will do this by comparing data collected from caregivers of individuals with Down syndrome with and without a history of childhood cancer. We are recruiting caregivers of individuals with Down syndrome and no history of childhood cancer for this part of the study.

What can I expect to happen in this study?

The following is a list of activities that will happen during the study:

- 1. We will ask you to complete surveys that ask questions about your child's thinking, learning, behavior, and quality of life. Surveys can be completed on a computer, by mail, or by phone.
- 2. We will ask you to complete surveys 3 times over a period of 3 years.

Compensation

Participants will receive a \$50 gift card for each time point completed (so up to \$150 total).
