

Getting To and From Capitol Hill

NDSS SPONSORED BUS SERVICE

NDSS will be providing transportation from the event hotel and venue to Capitol Hill for all attendees via charter busses on the morning of May 13th. Busses will begin loading at the front entrance of the hotel at **7:30 AM**. The last bus will depart promptly at **8:00 AM**.

NDSS will also be offering limited seating on two return busses. These busses will depart from Capitol Hill at **5 PM** and **6:30 PM**. Seats on these busses will be offered on a first-come, first-serve basis. Advocates planning to ride these busses should arrive at the pick up location (see star on map to the right) early.

Busses will drop off and pick up on East Capitol Circle on the West side of the United States Capitol building. To navigate to this location, advocates can insert "Ulysses S. Grant Memorial" into their maps.

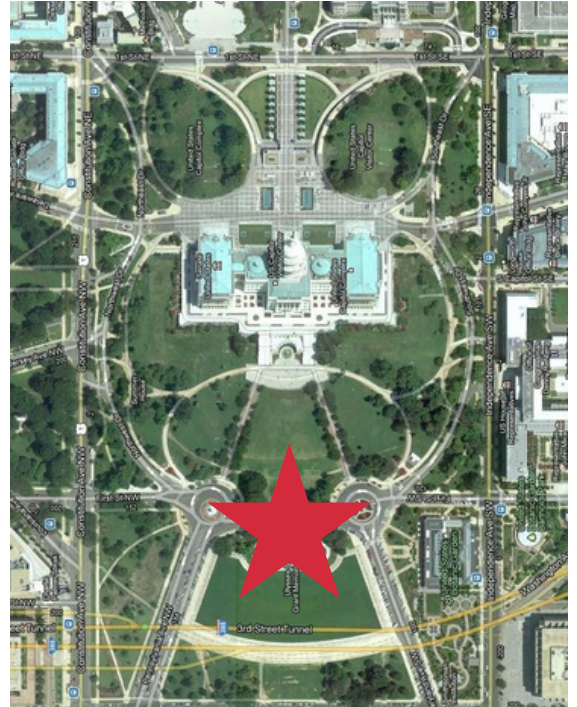
RIDESHARE

Ubers, Lyfts, and taxis are a common way to get around Washington, DC. The average cost for a rideshare app ride begins at \$12. Please note that the time you order an Uber, Lyft, or Taxi will affect the cost of the ride.

METRO (TRAIN) SYSTEM

Getting a Metro card:

There are Metro Card machines at the entrance to every Metro stop that accept cash or card. Purchase either a card or a day pass, depending on the length of your stay.. Once purchased, you can add more value to the card by the white lever attached to the machine. At this point, enter cash or card into the machine and it will print a new card for you. If you are adding value to a card, you may need to swipe the card along the circular patch so the card can electronically upload the new value.



**Accessibility Information:**

Metro offers braille, auditory, and language substitutions, and each train has designated accessible seats. Every Metro stop has an elevator however the elevator may be at a separate entrance from the main escalator. If you are unable to locate the accessible entrance or have difficulty accessing accessibility resources, you are encouraged to speak with a Metro operator at the local metro stop for assistance.

Directions on Metro:

Please allow 45-60 minutes to commute to the Capitol from Renaissance Arlington Capital View Hotel. It is a 10-minute walk from the hotel to Crystal City Metro Stop at 1750 S Clark St, Arlington, VA 22202. Board the Blue Line train going in the direction of Largo Town Center. The blue line runs every 8-16 minutes. Exit the train when it reaches the Capitol South Metro stop at 355 First St. SE, Washington, DC 20003. From here, refer to your schedule and begin walking in the direction of your first meeting.
