**Are you or someone you know an adult
with Down Syndrome (ages 35-65)?**

We're looking for adults with Down Syndrome (35-65 years old) and their caregivers/support people to take part in an exciting research study on spatial navigation and memory using fun games and tasks!

What Participation Involves:

- We will observe how adults with Down Syndrome navigate new places and use their memory through a series of games and tasks
- 2-3 days (about 4 hours total, with breaks)
- Flexible Locations: our lab, home, or a service provider site
- To participate, caregivers/support people must be at least 18 years or older and willing to take part in the study
- Adults with Down Syndrome who complete the study will receive a \$120 gift card as compensation for their time (via giftogram)

Why This Study Matters:

- 90%+ of people with Down Syndrome will develop dementia in their lifetime.
- Early signs are unique and often missed.
- Your help leads to better tools for earlier care and support.
- Shine a light on an underresearched community.
