

Research Study on Sibling Relationships in Down Syndrome

You May Qualify If You

- One sibling is an adult with Down syndrome (age 18 or older)
- One sibling is an adult (age 18 or older) without a disability
- Both siblings are willing to participate
- Both siblings are able to participate in separate virtual interviews

Location:

Participation takes place remotely via Zoom.

Participation Involves

- A short online questionnaire completed by the sibling without a disability before the interview
- Separate interviews with each sibling, with questions about sibling relationships, shared activities, and life experiences, etc
